Registration Information

RESIDENT REGISTRATION FOR SPRING PROGRAMS BEGINS ON JANUARY 2, 2012 for all programs.

NON-RESIDENT REGISTRATION FOR SPRING PROGRAMS WILL BEGIN ON FEBRUARY 1 for all programs **except** spring swim instruction and street hockey, which begins on Monday, January 16, and pavilion registration which begins on April 1.

- Hampton residents will be given priority.
- Registrations cannot be accepted by mail or in person prior to the beginning of the registration period.
- Registrations will be returned if received prior to the registration date.
- Please register early in the registration period. Classes do fill quickly, and registration is on a first-come, first-served basis starting the first day of registration.
- First fee listed is for Hampton residents / second fee listed is for non-residents.**
- Fees subject to change without notice.**
- Please be sure to complete the registration form in full.
- There are no exceptions. Please do not ask us to exceed class size limits or to put your child in the wrong age, skill level, or class. We try our best to accommodate everyone. Programs are designed according to age levels and instructor / student ratios that will benefit the students.
- Please write a **separate check for each program** made payable to **Hampton Township**.
- Attach your check or money order to the registration form.

Admission Policy and Fees

All patrons and guests will enter through the main entrance and check-in at the service desk. All children 9 years old and under must be accompanied by an adult at least 18 years old. Each patron 10 years old and up will be issued a photo ID admission card, which must be presented upon each admission. All photo ID cards will be issued at the Community Center Service Desk. Community Center ID Cards will be issued annually. Fee \$30/\$60 for adults, \$18/\$36 for youth. Program activity fees are subject to change without notice. First fee is for Hampton residents/second fee is for nonresidents. ID Card fee now includes admission to all open gyms, family movies, youth dances and Toddler Time!

Youth Open Gym

The community center open gym is reserved for non-structured open gym free play use each day for youth only. You provide the ball, we provide the court. The gym can be set up for multiple uses as needed. Community Center ID card is needed for admission. Scheduled organized team practice and/or private instruction not permitted. Facility Use Rules

Enter via main entrance and with DCS issued ID card only. No loitering inside or out; no smoking in the facility; no skate boarding or roller blades on sidewalk; drop-off/ pick-up area in front of building; no parking in the fire zone.

Indoor Walking & Jogging Track

The elevated walking & jogging three-lane track is open to all ages & abilities during normal community center hours of operation. Thirteen laps on the rubberized track equal one mile. The track is located on the mezzanine level of the community center, overlooking the gymnasium as well as the facility lobby. The exterior walls have windows, which offer a unique view of Hampton Community Park. Appropriate footwear is required. Community Center ID card is required for admission.

Spring Swim Class Registration

Swim Class Levels

Infants/Parent: Ages six months to two years. An adult must enter the water and accompany the child at all times. Introduction to water and safety skills.

Please do not use regular disposable diapers. Cloth diapers with tight fitting plastic pants or disposable "swimming" diapers are preferred.

3-5 Years Old/Parent: Introduction to water, start kicking, arm strokes, start back float and safety skills.

3-5 Years Old Advanced/Parent: Should be floating unaided, use of kick and arm strokes and safety skills.

Level I: 6 years old & up, at least 4 ft. tall, no experience

Level II: At least 4 ft. tall, must have passed Level I

Level III: Must have passed Level II

Level IV: Must have passed Level III

Level V: Must have passed Level IV

FIRST DAY OF REGISTRATION:

- RESIDENTS—with or without 2012 pool pass
- NON-RESIDENTS—with 2012 POOL PASS
 - Saturday, April 21, 8:00 until 10:00 a.m. in the Hampton Community Center Great Room.
 - Registration will continue at the D.C.S. service desk until all classes are filled or classes begin.
 - Non-Resident registration begins on Tuesday, May 1, 8:00 a.m. at the D.C.S. service desk.
- REGISTRATION for summer swim classes must be done in person.
- No registrations will be accepted through the mail or by phone.
- All fees must be paid at the time of registration.
- Each class meets for ten-consecutive days, Monday through Friday at the same time.
- Proof of residency for Hampton residents may be required.
- Pool pass confirmation will be required for non-residents registering before May 1.
- Participants *may only register for one session at a time.
- Participants *may register for an additional session the Thursday before the session desired begins.

Verification of prior level of accomplishment needed in order to move up to the next level.

PLEASE SEE THE HAMPTON COMMUNITY POOL PASS POLICIES & PROCEDURE FOR 2012 FOR ADDITIONAL IMPORTANT INFORMATION. Please call the DCS office at 412-487-7870 for more information. Renewing Pool Pass Holders should not discard their Pool Pass ID Card...beginning in January, pool passes can be renewed. Fill out a 2012 pool registration form, attach your check and mail to the Department of Community Services, 3101 McCully Road, Allison Park, PA 15101. Upon receipt of the **RENEWAL** registration form and payment your pool pass ID card will be renewed. The pool pass IDs can also be renewed in person at the Community Center Service desk during normal operating hours. Reminder: ages 10 and older must have a photo pool ID card; ages 3-9 must have a non-photo ID card.

The Township of Hampton Department of Community Services (DCS) pool pass photo system and procedure for the 2012 season will remain the same. All pass holders age 10 and above will be issued a plastic color photo pool pass swipe card. Pool passes/photos will only be issued from the Hampton Community Center service desk. All pass holders will be required to present their photo ID pool passes at the pool admission desk to have their pass swiped for verification prior to entering the pool.

Registration and payment will be accepted via mail or in person. When submitted via mail the registration information will be processed and filed until the pass applicant visits the Community Center to have their digital pass photo taken. Inform the service desk attendant that your registration information was mailed and you will be issued a pool pass photo ID card. When registering in person the pool pass photo will be taken at that time. Pool guest pass format and procedures have not changed.

The Township of Hampton, Department of Community Services (DCS) "hotel style" fitness area, located on the Mezzanine Level of the Hampton Community Center, is available during regular community center hours of operation (unless posted otherwise). Admission to the fitness area is by the community center service desk via a "fitness photo ID admission pass card or paying the daily admission fee." Twenty nine pieces of equipment are available, including fourteen cardio and fifteen weight training, which includes dumbbells. Free weights are not included.

Two (2) Automatic Electronic Defibrillator (AED) units are also available should the need ever arise for use by trained certified DCS staff or patrons. A unit is located on the lobby wall of the main gym entrance doors and the other is located at the top of the mezzanine fitness area stairway next to the lockers. As is the practice with other use areas of the community center, the fitness area will not have constant direct supervision. The on-duty facility manager will provide routine walkthrough monitoring. If at any time during your use should you have any questions or require assistance do not hesitate to speak with the facility manager or service desk staff.

Prior to using the fitness area for the first time, each patron is required to read and sign the rule/release form and receive from a DCS staff member an in-person, hands-on equipment use orientation.
